### **Parliamentarians' Petition on Tibet**

We, the undersigned parliamentarians of democratic countries all over the world being alarmed at the escalating situation of persistent violation of human rights and fundamental freedoms of the Tibetan people, including deep concerns over the drastic action of self-immolations, initially by monks, to demonstrate in defence of their rights.

Having noted that there is no good faith approach from the Chinese authorities to resume the Sino-Tibetan talks.

Deeply concerned that no independent observers, including United Nations human rights experts and the foreign media are being allowed to enter Tibet.

Call on the Chinese Government to:

- Grant the Tibetans the maximum degree of self-governance as outlined in the “Memorandum on Genuine Autonomy for the Tibeans People” presented by Envoys of the Dalai Lama during the eighth round of Sino-Tibetan talks held in Beijing on 4 and 5 November, 2008;
- Respect and implement the provisions of the Chinese Constitution for effective realisation of provincial autonomy;
- End the suppression of peaceful protests in Tibet and the cycle of arbitrary detentions and enforced disappearances of Tibetans, including human rights defenders;
- Respect universally recognised inalienable human rights in Tibet and China, including freedom of religion, freedom of speech, freedom of association and
